

NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY AT MIDDLE CREEK HIGH SCHOOL

The Middle Creek High School chapter of the National Honor Society welcomes the interest of students and their parents. A Faculty Selection Committee will select students for membership in the NHS. Induction, which will be held once a year, is open to juniors and seniors. All students must have an academic average of at least 3.8 GPA weighted. (Note: No GPA will be rounded up to meet the minimum 3.8 criteria. For example, a 3.79 will not be considered.) The advisor is Mr. Gene Osborn.

The membership selection criteria and methodology will consist of the following six points. (1) Names will be posted of students who have met the eligibility requirement of a **3.8 weighted GPA**, based on grades earned in the ninth and tenth grades for juniors and ninth, tenth, and eleventh grades for seniors. (2) Eligible students who are interested in NHS membership must complete an activity sheet and return this required information to NHS advisors by the announced deadline. Students need to treat the activity sheet like a college resume, being very specific and clear with the information. Activities on and off campus are important; however, **three activities at Middle Creek High School and one community service project completed during the past year are required.** From the freshman year to the present, growth will need to be seen in activities. School support and involvement is very important. (3) Prospective members must meet with the co-advisors for an information sharing session. (4) Recommendation sheets will then be distributed to all faculty members who are asked to evaluate the prospective member's **character, leadership, and service.** (5) Prior to meeting with the Faculty Selection Committee, the advisors will gather information about each student's activities and the faculty members' comments. (6) The Faculty Selection Committee will then meet to consider the information and vote on prospective student members. The committee will decide by a majority vote. **Remember, GPA alone does not guarantee NHS membership.** All prospective members must meet all of the above criteria.
