

High School Juniors: Planning Timeline

Summer/Fall 2007

- Complete summer reading assignments, if necessary.
- Review junior year schedule and transcript.
- Update High School Planner in CFNC.
- Prepare to take the PSAT exam-October 17. All juniors will take the PSAT free of charge. Free prep courses are available at www.cfnc.org and www.collegeboard.com.
- Start to think of colleges, majors and careers of interest.

Winter 2007-2008

- Attend College Panel Night-November 14, 7-8:30pm.
- Attend PSAT Night-December 12, 7-8:30pm.
- Attend Financial Aid Night-December 5, 7-9pm.
- Prepare for first semester exams.
- Meet with counselor to discuss registration for 2008-2009 classes (January-March).

Spring 2008

- Register to take the SAT (Test dates: January 26, March 1, May 3 and June 7).
- Prepare for AP exams.
- Research colleges and their entrance requirements.
- Visit colleges and universities of interest.
- Attend MCHS's College Fair (March).
- Attend local college and university college fairs.
- Identify teachers that will be willing to write a letter of recommendation.

Summer 2008

- Review transcript, graduation requirements and courses for 2008-2009 school year.
- Visit colleges and universities, schedule interviews and tours with college admissions counselors.
- Division I and II Athletes: Apply to the NCAA Clearinghouse.
